

One of the things that sets this series apart is that Britt, our protagonist, is more than just a narrator things happen to, she is an enjoyable character to follow. Oftentimes I find I like the male lead, but the female feels like more of a plot device than a person--happily that is not the case

with Britt Arthurs. She is a rational woman in her mid-twenties making the best of her unusual circumstances & seems to be aware that she can't elevate her personal desires over the commitments of the role she is forced to play. A refreshing turn for a woman in YA fantasy.
