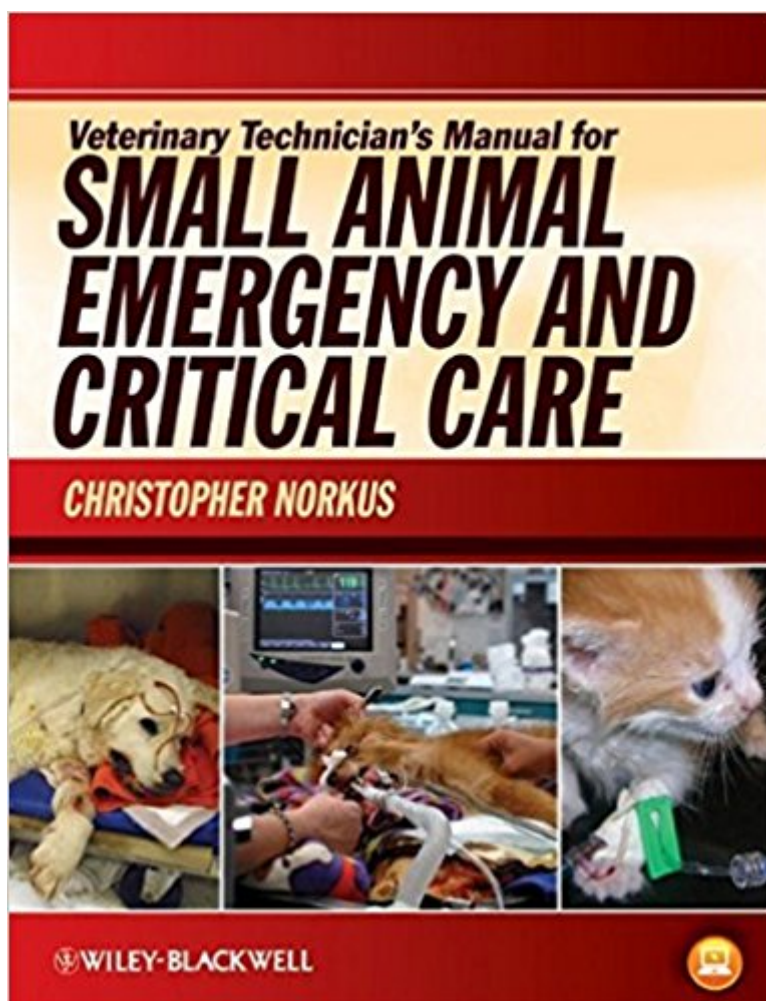

It is easy to navigate and has way more info than I expected. I would recommend this to any Veterinary Technician who wants a great guide to emergency and critical care.

I am impressed by how ambitious this text is w/several detailed chapters. The CV chapter explains complex systems very well. I would just advise careful reading as I have noticed some mistakes. The Critical Care Pharmacology chapter is great, but there are 2 mistakes in the medical calculation section, a Glyco dose answer is incorrect, and one should use subtraction not multiplication in a fluid additive question on step 1, p 427. There are also significant spelling errors/typos throughout. Overall though, a very good text.

This book is great, and contains a *lot* of great information. If you're looking to work in an emergency clinic, I would highly suggest purchasing this book.
