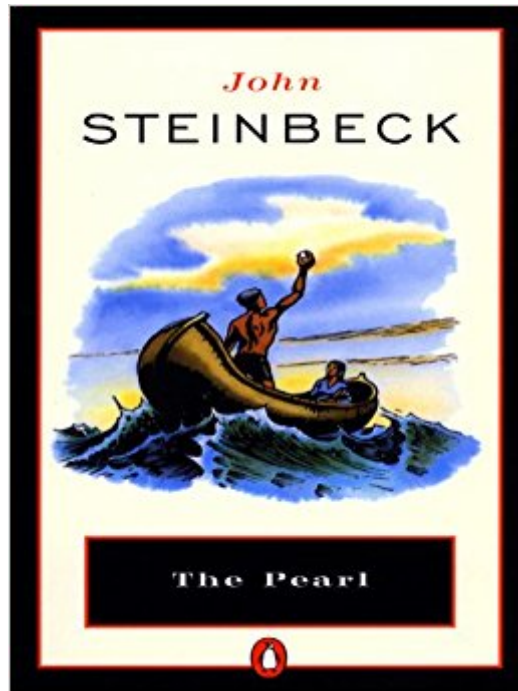




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The Pearl (Penguin Great Books Of The 20th Century)
