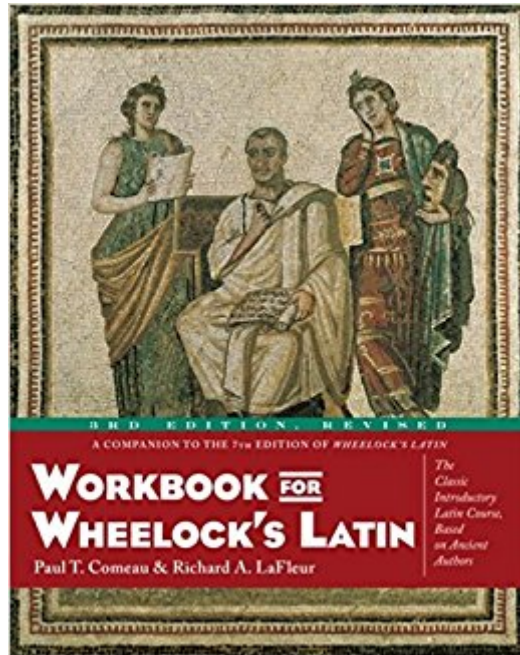




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Workbook For Wheelock's Latin

textbook itself. I would highly recommend this to anyone using Wheelock's Latin.
