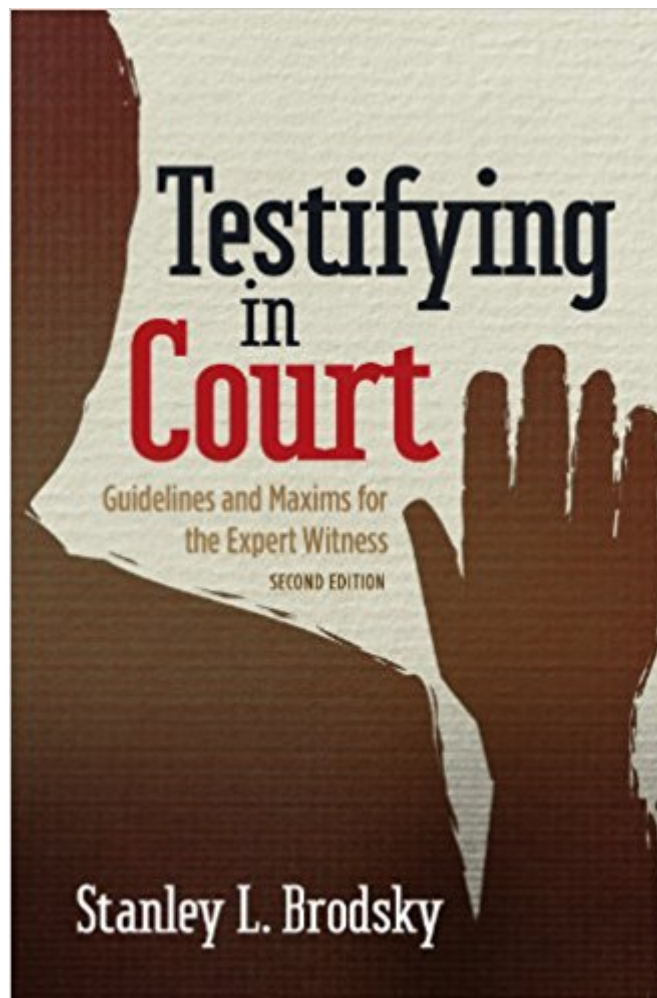




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Testifying In Court: Guidelines And Maxims For The Expert Witness, Second Edition
