

Our 5 year olds loved this tiny little travel guide! It made our trip to Venice fun for the whole entire

family, not just Mom and Dad loving Venice while twins complain about anything that isn't eating pizza and gelato. With some pencils and this Treasure Hunt, we were walking up church steeples, over bridges, and through piazzas, art galleries and history museums, with smiles on our faces! My only complaint is that there aren't more versions - we loved Venice and Florence to pieces.

Fantastic! I am so sorry that there aren't many more of these for other cities. Firstly, it is pocket size. Being small and compact, kids can have it on them. It is spiral bound and easy to tuck in a pen along with the book. Secondly, it has a point scoring system which encourages kids to ask for activities. My son was literally planning each day of our trip based on the book at age of 7! He would get mad at me if I skipped visiting a site because he would not score those points. Thirdly, educational but fun. It encourages kids to find "treasures" such as a particular painting and answer a question. Lastly, you will have it as a reminder of the trip at the end of the trip.

This kept my 8 year old involved in the city. He wanted to do as much as possible so wasn't as grumpy when we were sightseeing & I think he learned something too.

When I received this book I was disappointed. All in black and white, and very small. However, my kids LOVED it! They spent countless hours while on vacation looking for the things mentioned in the book and counting up points.

This was a great little book for keeping our 7 year old engaged and excited about our visit to Venice. We looked through it ahead of time so he knew the things he was to watch for (like lions and pigeons) and he would actually remember things himself and want to 'get points' from the book. Some other reviewers complained about the size (it is small) but I found it perfect because it fit in my purse and I could easily pull it out when we were in a line up or on a vaporetto. I saw other parents and travellers gazing over at us when we were filling it in or reading out from it, and I think they were envious and curious. I would definitely recommend it.

Tiny tiny book. Not worth the money IMHO.

My daughter LOVED this book during our recent trip to Italy. It helped keep her engaged and even taught us adults a thing or two about the different landmarks. I would highly recommend it!

This product is smaller than the size of my hand. It is tiny. It has basic items for the treasure hunt. I could have made this myself with minimal effort. The cost should be about 2\$, nothing more.
