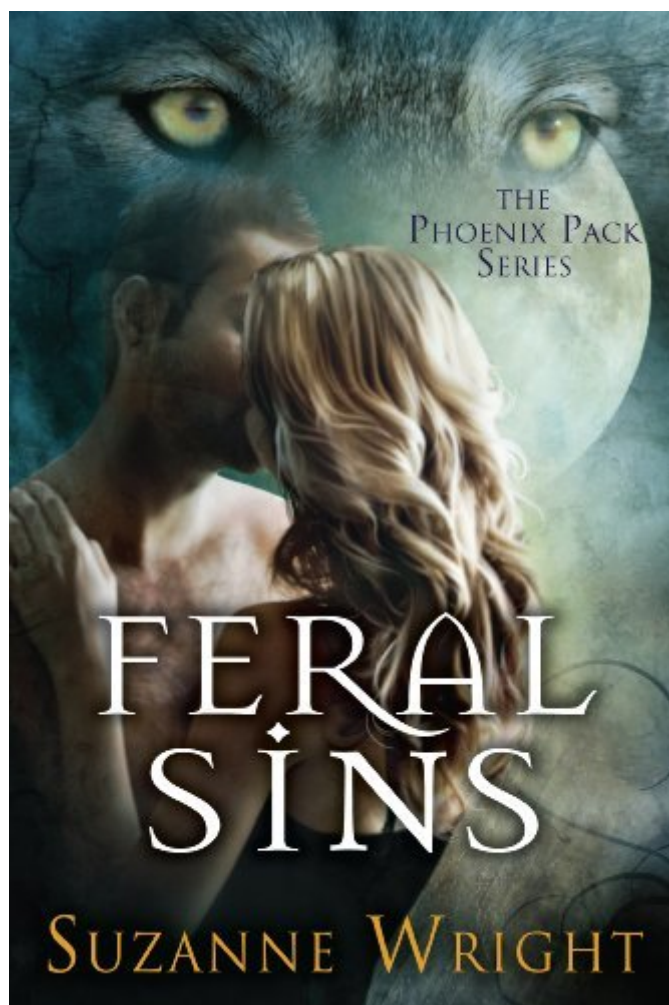

Synopsis

This book is great. The heroine is an alpha wolf shifter who can't shift (called a latent) and a healer. The hero is an alpha wolf shifter and leader of a pack that can't always control his wolf. They both

had awful childhoods, they both thought they would never get a chance for a true mate. So, when the alpha of another pack claims the heroine with a bite, and Taryn's father (alpha of her pack) goes along with it, scheduling her mating ceremony against her will, she is open to almost any alternative. The hero offers that alternative via a pretend, temporary mating, because he needs alliances to protect his pack from being taken over. She accepts. The pretend mating goes as planned, and she joins Trey's pack as the alpha female. As time goes on, through many difficulties, they become close. Ultimately, we have a great happy ever after. Some of the things I loved about this book are the ideas of a latent female alpha wolf, the descriptions of healing, the way our hero's wolf goes feral, but can be calmed by his mate, the fighting, the dynamics of the interactions within the pack and between packs, and many other very original ways of describing life as a wolf shifter. There is also the development of the hero into a more balanced wolf shifter who is more open to the softer feelings, and in better control of his wolf. The thing is, that sounds a bit dry as I write it, but everyone should realize the story is spiced up by the heroine's sarcastic sense of humor, and great, funny dialogue-sometimes for no particular reason. Also, there is sex. Lots and lots of sex (in a variety of ways) between two people who are mated (though temporarily at first) and coming to care about each other. I strongly recommend this book.

He loves how she fights him, doesn't submit to him, is protective of him as he is of her and wants him just as much if not more sexually than he wants her. This is one sexy as \$#@! shifter, one that could dominate me any day of the week. *Sigh* You also meet the rest of Trey's pack and even the old mean grandmother is one of my favorite characters in this book. The back and forth between her and Taryn is hilarious and neither backs down. The other wolves are just as funny at times, even when there are one or two that I would like to take by the throat because of how they act. Watching Trey and Taryn work through their own issues while at the same time becoming closer was great. Even when Trey acts like an @\$\$, the second that Taryn needs him, he is there and changes his ways. I have been in a

paranormal mood as of late and bought Feral Sins not knowing if I would like it or not, but I didn't just like it I absolutely loved it. Paranormal romance fans need to pick up Feral Sins because it is not just a sexy read but hilarious one that will have you in tears from laughing so hard at Taryn's comments at the same time. I am purchasing book two just so that I can read more of this series by Suzanne Wright.

There are two written versions of this book. I only realized it when I also purchased the unabridged audible book. The audible book that I listened to was different than the kindle book I originally purchased in 2012. The audible version I recently purchased has missing portions when compared to the kindle version I purchased in 2012. Out of curiosity, I went back and looked up the book on that is offered now. As it was offered under Kindle Unlimited, I selected it. The 2013 version that is now offered matches the audible book I purchased. I am curious as to the two versions. Usually a later version is an expanded version but the later version has been slightly cropped from the original 2012 version.

This is a wonderful shifter romance, which is the first in the series. The characters are strong, sarcastic, funny, and sexy; you can't help but adore them (and wish they were real). I especially like how the main characters relationship develops over time and how well they complement each other. There is plenty of action, drama, romance, incredibly hot sex (with a lot of dirty talk), and a HEA. Please note that there is one group sex scene (which is unbelievably hot), but if you're not into that sort of thing its easy to just skip past it. If you enjoy supernatural themed romance, I highly recommend this series.
