Dan Abnett lives and works in Maidstone, Kent. After graduating from Oxford, he worked for a while as an editor of comics and children's books before turning to writing full time. In the dozen or so years since then, he has written for such a diverse range of characters--including Scooby-Doo, Thunderbirds, Conan the Barbarian, The X-Men, Johnny Bravo, Batman, Rupert the Bear, Doctor Who, Mr. Men, The Terminator and Postman Pat--that he is now clinically bewildered. He created the popular series SINISTER DEXTER, which he continues to write, along with other strips, for 2000 AD, and has helped rejuvenate RESURRECTION MAN for DC Comics.

If you're a huge fan of the original Wally West, you'll love Titans Rebirth Vol. 1. I was extremely happy with tears of joy when the original Wally West (Kid Flash and The Flash after Barry Allen) was brought back into the DC Universe. In Titans Rebirth Issues 1-6, Wally has successfully reunited with old best friends and they're together again as the Titans after shocks that suddenly regained their memories of their past friendships. Now they're trying to figure out who or what has been stealing ten years of their lives and why? That's all I can about it for now because I highly recommend you pick up this trade paperback. You'll really it. Also, I love Wally's new suit. It's like his original Kid-Flash suit but red & silver as a symbol to remind him that "You're not Kid-Flash anymore. You're a Flash!"

DC Rebirth has been a great story line and I love this story on the return of one of my favorite characters. Dan Abnett does a masterful job with the adult Titans and their friendship and love over the years.

I am loving this series. Seeing the Titans back together again is so great. Dan Abnett's writing is fantastic, you can feel the love and care he's putting into each character and the story. The art is great too. I won't go into story details, but this series makes you care for the characters and reminds you how much you've missed this group. Highly recommend!

I am a fan of the Teen Titans since the 2003 animated cartoon. From there I dug deeper into the

comic books that inspired the show [and Teen Titans Go] where I learned the truth and the team history from the Silver Age to the Wolfman/Perez era to the Geoff Johns era. It was from there the original Titans - Robin, Kid Flash, Aqualad, Wonder Girl, & Speedy - were always the founding members and always served as friends and family to one another. As they became full grown adults they became Nightwing, Flash, Tempest, Troia, and Arsenal/Red Arrow....but was before FLASHPOINT. Then came Titans Hunt [the 2016, not the 1990s story-arc] when the original Titans reassembled and DC Rebirth when [the Caucasian] Wally West returned from Flashpoint to play a large role against the impending threat of Doctor Manhattan from Alan Moore's Watchmen. This story plays a role as clues about Doctor Manhattan are on display when the reassembled Titans reunite against the man who made Wally West disappear from the New 52: Abra Kadabra. I know this classic Flash adversary has been around since 1962, but he did kinda remind me of Mumbo Jumbo from the Teen Titans cartoon [along with an aspect from the Puppet King from the cartoon]. It was fun reading this graphic novel and the art done by Brett Booth, who is no stranger to the Titans after his artwork on the New 52 Teen Titans back in 2011. Hope we'll continue to see more fun and excitement in the upcoming "Lazarus Contract" where its Teen Titans and Titans against Deathstroke.

I've read the first 4 issues and I really am enjoying it. Solid Titan team, the art is simply amazing, and the story a good pace and entertaining.

I loved the 1st volume! It was great and I highly recommend it to anyone who read the rebirth. The only thing I didn't like was the condition the comic came in. I had it replaced since the back cover was completely creased from side to side. When I got my new copy I was not happy with it either. Might just be USPS not giving a damn.

Great for long term fans of the characters though I feel some new time readers will be lost with the character dynamics. Art is very energized, though some people are critical of Brett Booth's 90s style artwork but it didn't detract from my enjoyment.
