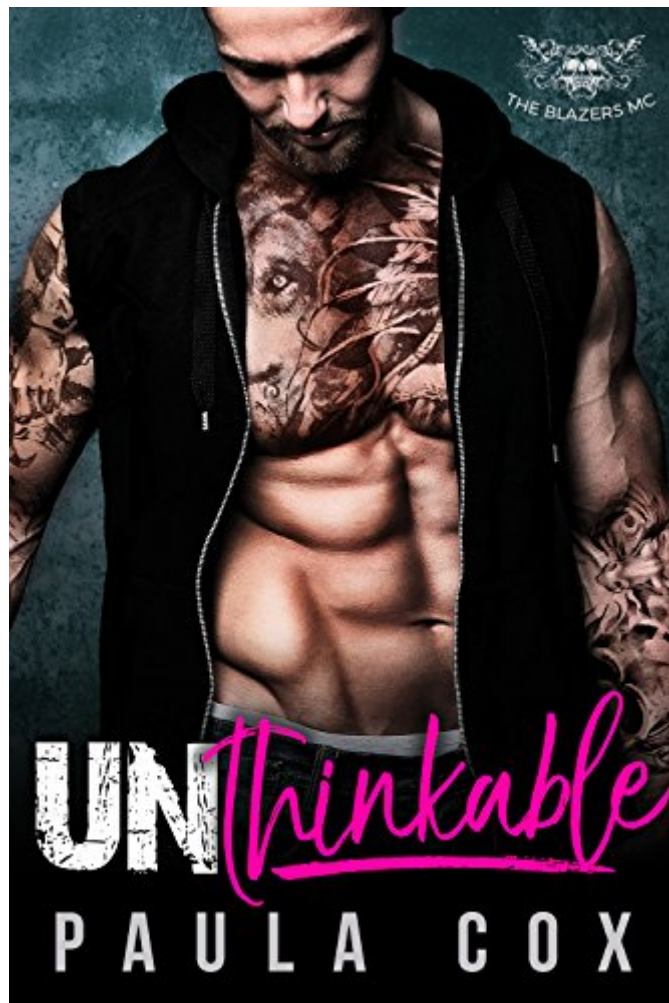




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Unthinkable: The Blazers MC

The story is complicated, with some nail biting suspense and sweet romance. It is complicated and compelling. Another great read, highly recommend.
