

The work is divided up by category like Anatomy and Physiology, Therapeutics, Toxicology, etc. later entries include diseases of the Cardiovascular System, Diseases of the Respiratory System, Diseases of the Digestive system etc. Taking Diseases of the Cardiovascular System there are General comments, Heart and Aorta, Angina Pectoris, Arteries***, Ligations of arteries***, Aneurysms, Veins, Thombosis: embolism, Cardiovascular Surgery, Disorders of the Blood***, Anaemia and Chlorosis***.
