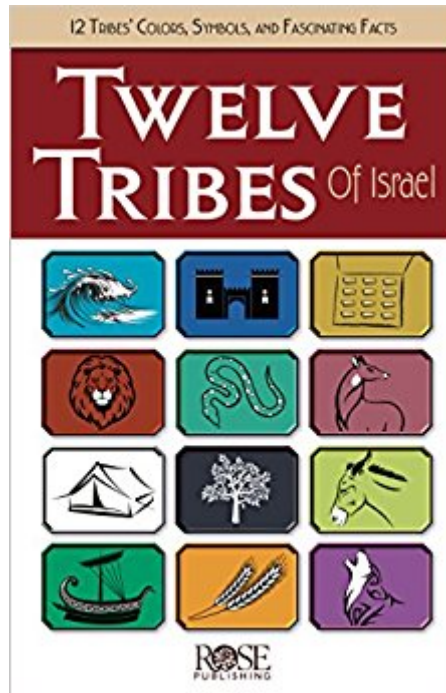

Benjaminite) to spread the gospel message to the Gentiles. In Revelation, the last book of the Bible, we are reminded of a remnant of 144,000 people sealed by Godâ 12,000 from each of the 12 tribes of Israel.

Great data in a small, attractive "package." I looked around for quite a while and this is the best I've found. It's hard to come by information on the symbols for the 12 tribes. This was well done.

I have found Rose Publishing to be very helpful, and illuminating on issue of the Bible and Religion in general.
