Fine for rank beginners and those who don't read music or have limited experience with an instrument. Helps to learn how to read music - very basic, but a good introduction.

I've used this method book quite successfully when teaching beginning recorder groups. It is written well in a clear and straightforward manner. There are many short exercises to work on before new notes are introduced. I usually start with Lesson 3, then 2, then 1. I like to start with teaching "B" first.

If you are new to the recoder, then get this. It assumes you know very little about music and walks you right up the recoder finger board. The intermediate and advanced users will find much of the

contents is too simple.
