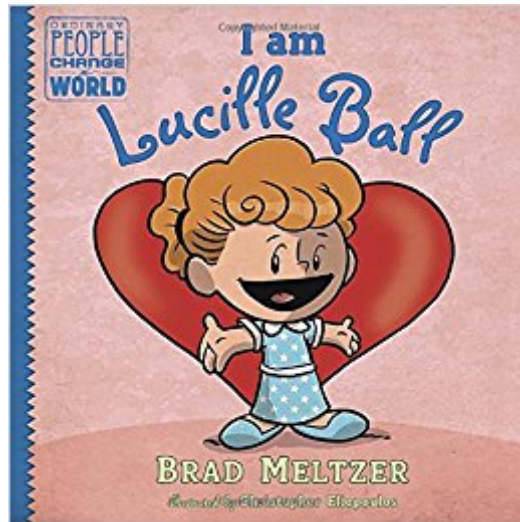

I have to admit that I'm a big fan of Brad Meltzer, and when I discovered his ORDINARY PEOPLE CHANGE THE WORLD series I gained even more appreciation for him. He is able to let us see not just the individuals behind the name but what helped them become who we know them to be. With I AM LUCILLE BALL we are able to see that just by her being comfortable in her own skin Lucy was able to become greatness not just on television but in life. It doesn't mean she was accepted everywhere she went, but she was able to not allow that to stop her---and neither should we. One of the great lessons that Lucy learned is that you have to trust that everything will be ok. She learned that when her dad used to throw her in the air, and she learned it when she trusted her gut and believed in her abilities. She also shows why it is so important for us not to compare ourselves to others. We have to love ourselves, and when we do we will be able to become exactly what is meant for us to become. Another job well done by Brad Meltzer. I AM LUCILLE BALL gives us the tools necessary to remember that regardless what our age we have to never give up on ourselves.
