One thing I was disappointed in was the fact that this was listed as a "Christian" romance and yet you could clearly tell by the characters that they were certainly not Christian. Referring to God as "the big man upstairs" hardly constitutes as a Christian romance book. All in all I loved this series and it would be a great movie trilogy....way better than the Twilight series.

Having read through the Harry Potter and The Hunger Games multiple times, I was looking for a series with similar characteristics - good depth to the plot, great character development, and a believable alternate world. While the premise for the series is wonderful - the ability to time travel into the past with an emphasis on archaeology and culture - I found the plot repetitious and lacking in any real depth. The same story line is repeated over and over. Girls travel to past, girls are attacked by evil men, girls prevail under circumstances that would kill any mortal. Girls meet handsome boys in past (disregarding facts like lack of basic hygiene and sanitation) and fall in love despite clear cultural chasms. It's so repetitious, I could not even finish the third book. Plus, I really could not buy the subplot of (spoiler alert!) the mother and girls being able to pull their father back from the dead. Too many dissonant time travel notes also made this a difficult read.
