

glossary of terms can be found in the back of the book, along with a list of websites if readers want to learn more on their own. A list of fun websites is also included which features puzzles and games for kids. Laidlaw does a great job of organizing important facts on Egypt for kids. Parents and teachers can introduce children to Egypt as well as grooming them for the use of larger fact finding books such as encyclopedias and almanacs

Three 'Crabtree Connections' titles are fine picks for grades 1-2, each offering some 24 pages of basic introductory facts.
