Great book. Very excellent for those of us that grew up loving and cherishing 90's pop culture. The topics covered range from fashion trends (footwear like L.A. Lights, girl trends like scrunchies, etc.),

toys (Beanie Babies, Furby's, Skip-It's), and much more, including movies, tv shows, sports (the Chicago Bulls!), etc. There's a lot of diversity here, and it's almost guaranteed that anyone of any age growing up in the 90's will find something they were fond of back in the day. Rollerblades, boy bands, pogs, tamagotchis, Goosebumps books, Power Wheels - it's just so much 90's goodness! The book itself is a very high quality print. Each page is thick, rich in color, and loaded with pictures. Chapters are short and can be read through in just a few minutes time (for the most part). Each write-up is fairly comprehensive and each section begs to be read and re-read over and over again. It's almost like flipping through a magazine. It even comes with an iron on transfer, a very popular gimmick magazines and such used to employ all the time. My one complaint is that the book would've been much more perfect if it were a large-sized coffee table book. And, although the book does a good job covering a lot of material, I really feel like it's only the tip of the iceberg when it comes to pop culture. There's a lot more that could have been covered, and a plethora of other topics just ripe for the picking. I also wish it covered more famous 90's events and news stories, but that's just me. Hope Amber Humphrey puts out another one of these!
