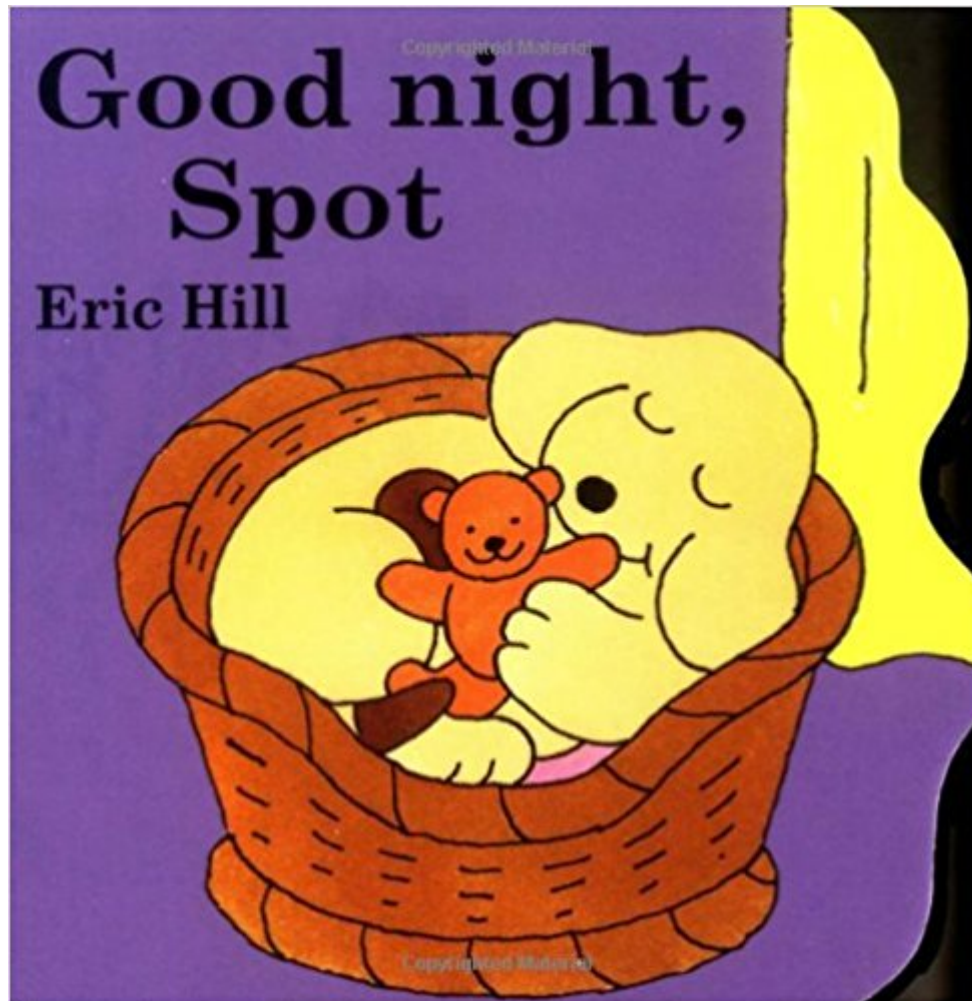

I expected that since it's a Spot book, and also, I felt like the picture on the front cover was a "flap" (the yellow coloring in the upper right hand corner?). Now, looking at all the Spot books, I realize this one didn't have the "lift the flap" star on the cover. Will definitely look for that in the future.

My eleven month old grandson loves this book. I bought this for him when he was younger. If you let him, this book would be read fifteen or more times a day. I have to put it away to get a break from it. It's really a joy to see and hear how much this book makes him happy. The book is simple and has

large pictures and writings for easy viewing and reading. Also, it is a good size book for your little one to hold.

In the search for more "Spot" books, I came across this one, and thought it'd be a nice little book to read to my toddler before bed. "Little" is right! This book fits in (practically) the palm of my hand, and the story is the same as all "night-night" books; play the day away, take a bath, pick a book, go to sleep. I guess I thought it'd be a lift-the-flap book (but that's my fault for not reading the product description correctly). It's okay...it hasn't gotten rave reviews from my dog-loving bookworm of a toddler either.
