Goodman Games has provided D&D players with old school adventures, d20 adventures and some innovative variations thereof. Their involvement in Cthulhu is a welcome addition to the system.

Just finished running this scenario last night. ****Spoilers****Pros:First off, the players had a blast. It is my belief that if your players have fun, the adventure was a success. Throughout the investigation, the players had a sense of impending doom, and they loved it. There are a lot of Cthulhu Mythos references in the story, so Lovecraft fans will enjoy that. The Milk of Shub-Niggurath Dream Visions were a nice touch. The adventure plays quickly and can be completed in 2-3 sessions. Cons: The encounter with the Dark Young is a bit overwhelming. Expect a character death or two if they don't immediately flee. The adventure is presented as "open" meaning that the characters can encounter the scenes in any order. However, if you have

• players who like to follow clues immediately, you can end up with some of the scenes becoming redundant or unnecessary if they are not encountered in the order presented. Like many published scenarios, the ending seemed abrupt. Overall, this is a good product. Like I said, we all had fun, and that's why we get together to game in the first place.
