Just what I needed.

It's okay.

You need a lot of personal innovation to make this work. It is impossible to balance the weight-bearing bar perfectly. Even if you could, motion will almost immediately imbalance the bar, and the weight on the down side will slip off and crash to floor. Meanwhile, the pull-down bar will attempt to give you a concussion. You have to build a guide of some kind to hold the weight bar steady. I built a wooden collar around the vertical sides with the weight bar running through the ends of the collar. This created a lot of wood-on-wood friction. Eventually, I had to abandon my machine because any load over 50 lbs. increased the friction to the point that one could not move the weight. On a real machine, I could pull down at least 100 lbs.

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
