

This was an impressive book if it was marketed as only LtGen Puller's military exploits. These were impressive. But marketing it as a whole-hog biography is disingenuous. Regardless, the tales in this book are impressive. I have a much better appreciation for why the Marine mascot is named Chesty. I would highly recommend this book to anyone looking for a read of the impressive exploits of an extraordinary Marine. For those looking for a true biography should look elsewhere.

Puller is the real deal. Others have discussed the book with a focus on Puller. Let me diverge to discuss the author's talents in describing the military situations Puller found himself in. Some books get into the details of terrain, formation, etc. Davis provided the essence of the battlefield - you felt the mud under your nails and gunpowder in your nose - without arrows and maps. Great job to provide the situation while keeping the focus on Puller.

This was a hard book to put down! I wish we had more like him in our military today! This is definitely a book I will read several times. As a history teacher I learned quite a bit and as a lover of adventure stories I was captivated!

In an age when real heroes are overlooked by so many, it is refreshing to be reminded of the life and times of a man who in his life did so much to protect our nation. Should be required reading in every high school in the country.

General Puller had one of the most interesting and all consuming military careers ever chronicled. His rise from enlisted to the General Officer ranks is an indication of his devotion to the Marines and to military service. The book provides an in-depth understanding of why our military at times suffers because of too many "staff" officers without combat experience.

Lead by example, lead with fairness, lead from the front! Lewis "Chesty" Puller was such a man, a legend in the eyes of his men and fellow Marines, common and unassuming in his own mind.
