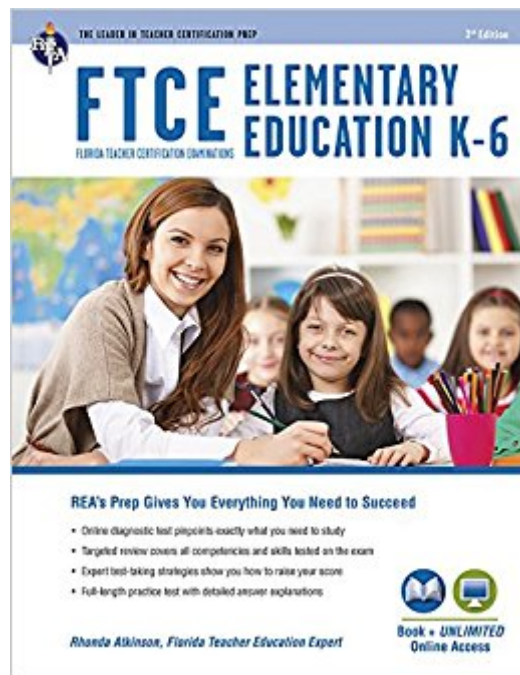

An Overview of the Test What is assessed on the FTCE Elementary Education K-6 test? The FTCE Elementary Education K-6 test is a subject area examination constructed to measure the knowledge and skills that an entry-level educator in Florida public schools must have. The test is a requirement for candidates seeking an Elementary Education K-6 certificate. Because it's a computer-administered test, the FTCE Elementary Education K-6 test is available throughout the year at numerous locations across the state and at select locations nationally. To find the test center near you, visit www.fl.nesinc.com.

What is the format of the FTCE Elementary Education K-6 test? The test includes a total of 220 multiple-choice items. Your test may include questions that are being evaluated for future administrations. These items will not count toward your score and you won't know which is which, so they aren't worth worrying about. Your final scale score will be based only on the scorable items.

When should the test be taken? Traditionally, teacher preparation programs determine when their candidates take the required tests for teacher certification. These programs will also clear you to take the examinations and make final recommendations for

certification to the Florida Bureau of Educator Certification. A candidate seeking K-6 certification may take the appropriate test at such time as his or her Educator Preparation Program (EPP) determines the candidate's readiness to take the test, or upon successful completion of the EPP, whichever comes first. The EPP will determine readiness through benchmarks and structured assessments of the candidate's progress throughout the preparation program. Taking the appropriate FTCE examinations is a requirement to teach in Florida, so if you are planning on being an educator, you must take and pass these tests. How do I register for the test? To register for the FTCE Elementary Education K-6 test, you must create an account in the FTCE/FELE online registration system. Registration will then be available to you online, 24/7. How should I prepare for the test? It is never too early to start studying for the FTCE. The earlier you begin, the more time you will have to sharpen your skills. Do not procrastinate. Cramming is not an effective way to study, since it does not allow you the time needed to learn the test material. It is important for you to choose the time and place for studying that works best for you. Be consistent and use your time wisely. Work out a study routine and stick to it. When you take REA's diagnostic test and practice tests, simulate the conditions of the actual test as closely as possible. Turn your television and radio off, and go to a quiet place free from distraction. Read each question carefully, consider all answer choices, and pace yourself. As you complete each test, review your score reports, study the diagnostic feedback, and thoroughly review the explanations to the questions you answered incorrectly. But don't overdo it. Take one problem area at a time; review it until you are confident that you have mastered the material. Give extra attention to the areas giving you the most difficulty, as this will help build your score.

UPDATE: I passed all four sections! I'm glad I went with this book. I'll look first to this series when I prepare for my other tests. This series has been recommended by friends in my education program, too. I took this test April 5, 2017, and the math section has definitely been updated since this book was last revised. The test may well have been updated only recently - I wasn't able to get instant scores today, because the Elementary K-6 test is currently considered under revision as of April 1, 2017. I don't fault the book for not being up to date on the math section, but I did want everyone to know. The ELA, science, and social studies sections, though, were extremely consistent with the material in this book, and I was very glad to have made this purchase! I'm a career-changer, interested in work in elementary education. The material in this book was very helpful. The test is a mixture of elementary education content (not as simple as you might think - you have been warned!) and corresponding teaching methods. In the science and social studies sections in particular, there

was a strong correlation between the material in this book (including teaching methods) and the material on the test. It was well worth the purchase just for this. All that being said, I didn't feel well prepared for the math section, and that is actually the section of this book I studied most closely. I did well on both online practice math tests. One of my undergraduate degrees is in a math-related area. I was actually looking forward to the math section, because I felt best prepared for it. There were references to several problem-solving methods that weren't familiar after having read this book. They did pertain to techniques I've helped my first-grader with in his schoolwork, so it's clearly up-to-date in terms of the kids' curriculum - but knowing how to help with my son's homework is completely different from understanding the education terminology and rationale for methods like decomposition. (But maybe I missed something in the book!) There was also a lot more calculation than I'd expected. A significant portion of my test (maybe 1/3-1/2 the questions is what it felt like) involved word problems with multi-step computations. I am someone who takes longer than average to complete computations, and I used to always have to not only learn math methods, but also practice, in order to complete tests as quickly as my peers. I am accurate, but slow! If I had known how much computation would be involved, I would have done more practice problems. I completed both online math tests from this book with time to spare, so I was shocked to realize midway through the actual test this morning that I was coming up short on time. Not only did I not have time to go back and check my work, I had to randomly choose answers to maybe four questions, because I didn't have time to complete them. Maybe this was on me! I'm not blaming the book for my disappointing test - and if the test was just updated, it's definitely not this book's fault. And, hey, maybe I passed - I don't know, because the test is under review, so there were no instant scores today. And again, the social studies and science sections could not have been more consistent with this book. ELA was pretty close, too. I'm VERY glad I purchased this. The book is well written, well organized, and complete without being overwhelming. For me, it was also a great text to study as a complement to my education coursework textbooks. I got the Kindle version, which was excellent. I do recommend getting this book - just maybe take some time to practice more story problems and computation (large-number multiplication, long division, geometry, etc.), and also seek out information about the very latest math methods happening in classrooms.

I had to retake the science and social studies portion of my FTCE, so I bought this book to see if it will help and it did - I passed!! The online tests are so helpful. It tells you exactly what your strengths and weaknesses are so you know what competencies to focus on. And it's almost like you're really taking the actual exam. I did not rely solely on this book though. It's a good idea to use

other books as well (The yellow one). But overall I'm glad I made the choice to purchase this book.

Once registered, the website does not allow you to sign back in. There is no customer service representative. Only static. Others on social media have had same issue for the last year, access codes do not work either. They have a FB page, and there is an automated reply message that if you need help with the Study Center choose option 4. However, is not even an option. Do not buy this book. You wont be able to take practice tests.

I just took the exam and passed all 4 sub-tests. The material does not cover everything that is on the exam. Some of the questions and concepts I had never seen before. You have to be able to eliminate answers and critically evaluate the questions by looking for specific words in the test. If you can do this, you will pass. Good luck:))

The information in this book is overwhelming and not organized. For example, in the Social Science area, it jumps back and forth between time periods which makes it so confusing and difficult to understand. I would not recommend this book. I've been using study guides from the Internet instead and which I would have purchased a different study guide.

I brought this book with me to my certification department in Hillsborough county and they informed me this has not been updated with the changes made which are necessary to pass the test. It's frustrating to have spent all this time study for a test with inaccurate info and of course spending the money!

Just passed all but the math subtest on the FTCE K-6 by using this book and one other. The exam is 90% teaching and assessment strategies so don't waste your time trying to memorize all the science, math and social science content. There are some of those questions, but most of them will ask "which is the best strategy?, which is least effective?, which is most appropriate?, what strategy is being used?, etc. More than anything else, study the teaching and assessment strategies and make sure you really understand them and you will pass. The exam is pretty different from these practice tests so be sure you understand the strategies.

Extremely disappointed in the quality of this book. Many answers to the questions on the test in book are misliding and incorrect. The same applies to the online test the book provides. In a photo

there is an example of how incompetent the authors are.

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
