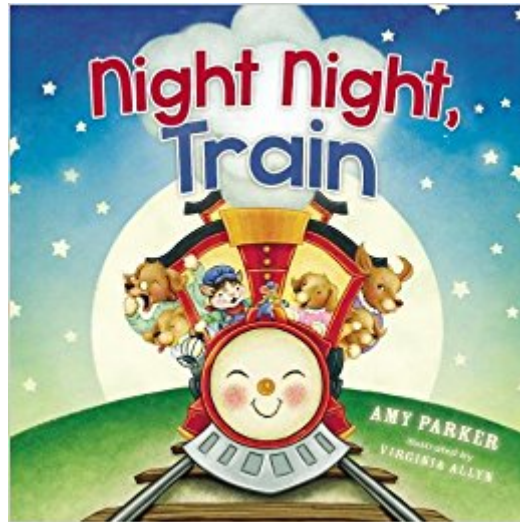

With no scary scenes, it is a nice story about a train with a family of dogs that heads to Sleepytown. Full page color illustrations of the animals on the train cover the pages. Written in rhyme with some complicated wording, this tale involves a dog family of six boarding a train and getting a ride to bed while on it. With the furry pets getting tickets and entering the train, they find their seats, share a meal, read a book, take a bath, get into their pajamas, pray to God, climb into bed, and get a good night's sleep, knowing that God is in control.~Why ~Having two granddaughters who are ages four and one years old, their routine is similar to this book in that they take a bath after dinner, read a book, and then get tucked into bed. I like how the book involves a train ride to bedtime and God loving us. The puppies are cute and adorable.~ Why Not ~Those who do not like books that mention God may not approve of this book, but He is mentioned only three times. Some may not have the same bedtime routine as the book explains.~ Wish ~There is nothing I would change about this read.~ Want ~If you are looking for a book to read at bedtime that is short and sweet, this one may gently rock a child to sleep as it chugs along the bedtime rails. Night Night, Train by Amy Parker and illustrated by Virginia Allyn, is a sweet story that can help lull little ones to bed. The story begins with a family of dogs getting aboard the night night train to Sleepy Town. On their adventure, we see the family taking part in activities most families would like having dinner, reading a favorite book together, taking a bath, brushing teeth, and evening prayers. The book is written a rhyming way that flows quite well when read-aloud. Some of the text is displayed in a playfully illustrated manner on the pages. You could read the story as a whole or just the playful text. Either way, I found the story is well received. I feel the length is just right for a bedtime story for toddlers and kindergarteners depending on their attention span. But if a little one can't find another wink, I suggest just reading the playful text. The illustrations are a delight to look at. You can make a fun game and search for the little mouse which appears on almost every page while the story is being read. The coloring, lighting, and coziness of the pictures is absolutely perfect for a bedtime story. I adore that at the end of the book there's a reminder of God's love and care. To rest easy knowing God will keep them safe is perfect. My 14-month-old daughter loves listening to me read and we've made story time a part of our every evening. She took to this book right away. She always picks it up for me to read to her and often I find her looking at it all on her own. The

book is recommended for ages 3-5 but I feel it's great for the younger crowd too. Overall, this is a sweet book that's great for both boys and girls. I love that it's offered in board book-format as I know it will be read again and again. This format is also easy to keep clean or to take along when a child may be away from home and needing something familiar to help them fall asleep. As the engineer drives through Sleepytown, all the passengers say "night night" to everyone and everything they pass. I look forward to adding this to my newborn's little library. This book is not overtly christian but it does mention how God loves us and cares for us through all of our daily routines and life.
