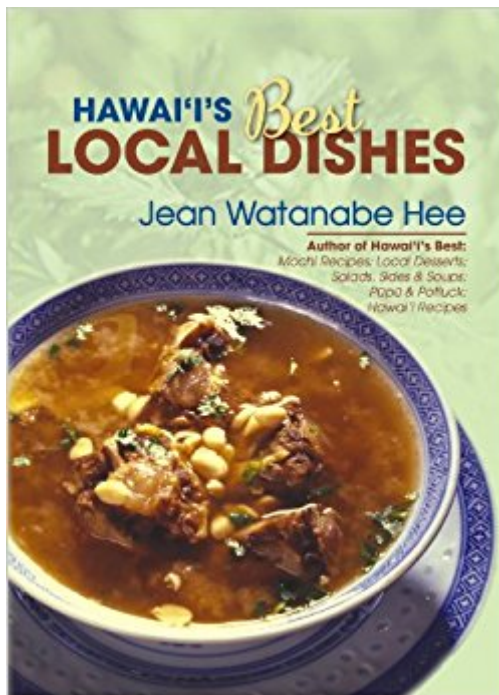

The author of the best selling cookbooks Hawaii's Best Mochi Recipes and Hawaii's Best Local Desserts now brings more than 140 favorite island recipes to the dinner table from savory Pork Adobo, Oxtail Soup and Honey-Glazed Walnut Shrimp to Lazy Style Lau Lau, Portuguese Bean Soup and the island-style Loco Moco. These are the recipes passed on from friends, coworkers, and relatives, the local favorites that are found at potlucks and beach barbecues throughout the islands. Many recipes are quick and easy for those who need to whip up a meal in 30 minutes or less after a long day at work.

I'm going to start off first of giving it 4 stars, but only based on looking at the book. I haven't tried out any of the dishes yet and may change my mind. The reason for the minus one star is that I expected more Hawaii's local dishes and not really other types of dishes. Granted there are a lot, I mean lot, of recipes but I guess I was expecting only Hawaiian style recipes. But there were other 'ethnic' dishes that were in there that I just didn't expect. Again I may change my mind once I do make it. The layout and number of recipes are nice and there are a lot of recipes. The spiral bound is nice because it does lay flat and I don't need to put my stapler and heavy weight down like other

cookbooks. Will update my review once I start cooking.

There are a lot of fancy tourist oriented Hawaiian cookbooks out there, which are written by chefs and use many expensive and hard to obtain ingredients. This book is not one of them. It has the food which Hawaiians actually eat every day, and that food is good! Hawaiian cooking is true fusion food, a product of the history of the islands and not of some chef's imagination. Hawaiian cooking combines elements of Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Filipino, Polynesian, American, and Portuguese cooking into a pleasing whole. The recipes in this cookbook are simple, straightforward, and delicious. Try the barbecued pork ribs made with orange marmalade. They are incredible.
