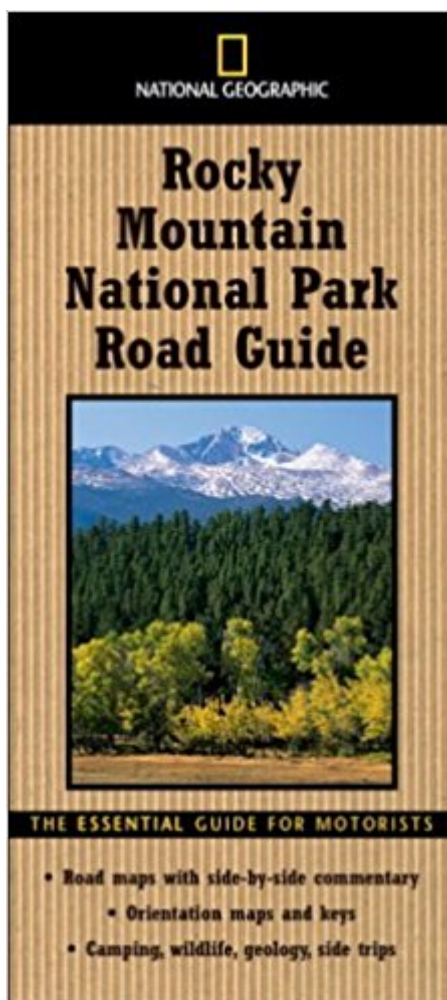


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National Geographic Road Guide To Rocky Mountain National Park: The Essential Guide For Motorists (National Geographic Road Guides)
