

The book is well organised, easy to read even if you have no medical- veterinarian preparation, with a table of contents to quickly find emergencies and another one to search for general topics that make easy to browse the book. The information is all the basics and non basics that any owner or breeder should know. Everyday reading and consultation material. Never got a question without answer with this book. This book has allowed me to understand more the behaviour, symptoms and best conditions to keep a cat with. With the guides of this book it's much more easier to talk with the vet about what is happening or might be happening to your cat and to help you even suggest what might be happening. Make me feeling more confident and peace minded about any emergencies that could happen as I've read this book from beginning to end several times and now I am aware of what I have to stare at to quickly react. This book has saved the life of some of our cats and I will be eternally thankful for that.

I can't claim to have read this whole book, but it clearly will be very helpful as a reference. I have

already talked with my vet about one of the things I read in the book that seemed to apply to my cat. The book is very thorough, though some of it seems pretty technical for a book meant for a layperson. Also, if you are squeamish, be warned that there are a couple of really pitiful photos of sick cats. Altogether a very useful book for an experienced cat owner, though something simpler may appeal if you have no previous knowledge of cat health.

I bought a copy of this book on after seeing an earlier edition in a local used bookstore. Just one bit of information in the book enabled me to treat a potentially dangerous condition at home without going to the vet, saving more than the cost of the book and the three other copies that I bought to give as gifts to friends; I can see that I'll be buying more copies for friends in the future. The vet approved of my treatment. The book's instructions are clear about what the owner can do and when the cat should be taken to the vet for treatment. It's a book that every cat owner should have in their library.

Having many kittens, come into our home for adoption, we have at times experienced a couple of kittens, not looking well, so we consulted this book first, which has been a very good source of information.

If you are doing any kind of cat rescue work THIS is the book you need! It is the best reference book I have come across, it is easy for the lay person to read and has just about every scenario you will come across as a rescuer. This has been my "Bible" for years and this updated version is even better than the last. It is especially helpful with orphaned kittens, telling you how much they should weigh, how much food they need and what you should expect developmentally. I can't recommend this book highly enough--I wish I could give it more than 5 stars!

This is a good handbook to have, I don't know how many times I had to look up a condition for my cats, like what type of worm they had so I could get them medicine...so on. I would really recommend this book to all cat lovers.
