

There's really no need to write a long drawn-out review of this book. This is, easily, the best, most comprehensive, most refined, and most entertaining guide to Maine, period. No part of this surprisingly vast and diverse state is left out. From ancient York, to sophisticated Portland, to the

remote highlands, it's all here. The selection of lodging, dining, shopping, and sporting options is particularly good, especially if you're interested in heritage and ecological tourism. Fodor and Moon guides don't even come close.

If you are planning to vacation in or travel throughout Maine, this is the perfect guide. It provides lots of detail for all interests ranging from dining to shopping to hiking. I was very impressed by the details given for little known destinations. We bought this to prepare ourselves for our trip to Acadia National Park. The guide is also very well made. Enjoy!
