

If you are into books like this this one is pretty accurate and much better than other similar series of books. My wife and I use it on occasion for kicks and giggles. Recommend the dirty series over the others!

I would recommend this book to anyone who actually wants to go to Japan and be able to speak casually (as opposed to what is taught in college classes) to people at clubs, on the street, etc. Sometimes it's frustrating when you can't learn exactly what you *want* to say, especially if you're wanting to hit on that cute Japanese guy/chick in class and you want to impress them. Even if you're not going to use it, it is very interesting and funny to read. This is for people who already have some knowledge of the Japanese language. I wouldn't recommend it for anyone who isn't familiar with Japanese sentence structure.

I picked this book up on a whim and I cannot believe how crazy it is. It is so much fun just to flip through which, in fact, we were passing around and doing. I would suggest it to anyone that wants an in depth view of the slang and phrase that *ehem* would NOT make the cut in a normal dictionary. This book is definitely not for children. There are sections that cover everything from slang terms, to fighting terms, to the nasty things you want to do to people. Everything a girl needs on her visit to Japan ;) My only problem with it is the fact that some of the phrases in it are a bit outdated. Other than that it is perfect!

An excellent companion for your Japanese studies. the title is a bit misleading, as it is not just 'dirty' words. There is a lot of information about the Japanese culture and how you should address others, along with phrases more useful than where is the toilet, train station, hotel, etc... There are different chapters about different situations as well as the two chapters (Scat and Sex) about 'dirty' words. Not comprehensive but quite useful.

I purchased this for my Stepson as a sort of mindless, funny novelty gift. He has shown increasing interest in relocating to Japan after college and has been doing the Japanese Rosetta Stone to learn the language fluently. When we first gathered 'round the table to check the book out we were

hysterically laughing. The back-and-forth stabs at correct pronunciation of some of the phrases was hilarious (especially when you factor in the outlandish accents and voice intonation). Unfortunately, after some further research (and once he gained a better handle on the language) he concluded that some of the phrases were inaccurate. Regardless, the humor value alone was worth the purchase. We still reference the book occasionally (often during parties or game nights) to find new underhanded insults and enhance our insult arsenal. You know what they say: A family that insults each other in several languages, stays together (nobody says that).

I am loving all the phrases included in this book! I got this as a sort of gag gift for my buddy going to Japan, and needless to say he is all set! This book covers all interesting and "need to know" phrases all from bedroom to bathroom and in between. Great idea if your studying Japanese or planning a trip over, or if you just want to have a good laugh!
