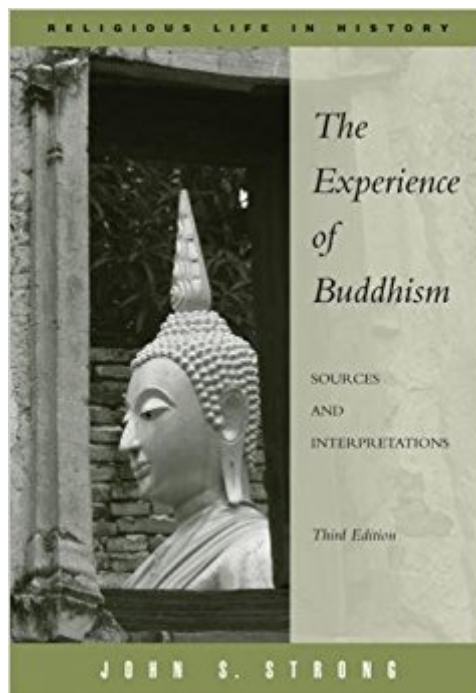

If you want to read yourself out of Buddhism this is a great book for you. I gave it five stars because it does not get much better than this in terms of scholarship and readability. The book takes the reader on a journey through the history of Buddhism with primary sources, commentary and suggested reading for further study. I completed this book with the sensation that I could leave the subject with a clean slate and move on to some other topic having been given a great overview and detailed analysis of the history of Buddhism.

A wonderful read, I would recommend this book to anyone wanting to achieve a deeper understanding of the teachings of the Buddha and the dissemination of that teaching in the years after his death. Although it is a textbook it is not cumbersome or difficult to read.
