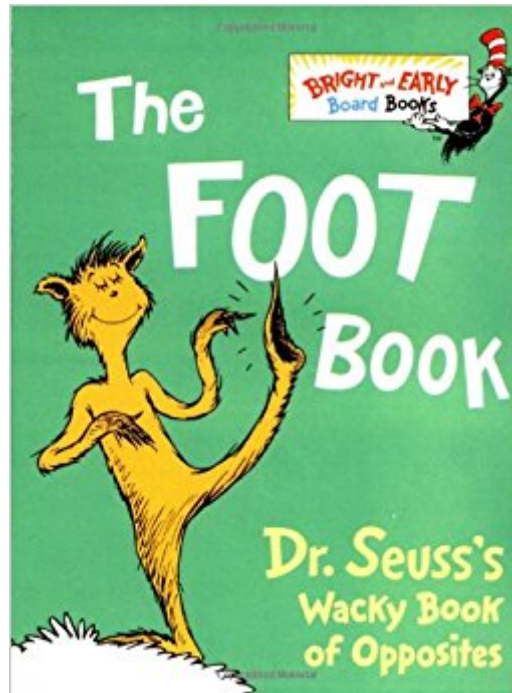

The Foot Book is a delightful tribute to the diverse and multifaceted world of feet. Not merely a realm of ankles, arches, and toes--as this self-proclaimed "Wacky Book of Opposites" attests--the podiatry province welcomes all kinds: "Slow feet/Quick feet/Well feet/Sick feet." Dr. Seuss has put his best foot forward here, in a whimsical approach to showcasing opposites. Wet feet contrast dry feet, and low feet contrast high feet. Though hot feet and cold feet aren't specifically referenced, we get the sense that those are okay too. As usual, the rhymes are quick and quirky, and Seuss's illustrations will knock kids' socks off. (Baby to preschool)

Almost any book by Dr. Seuss gets 5-stars from me, so, perhaps, I'm not the most objective reviewer. That being said, my daughter really enjoys this book. She's 13-months-old, and she enjoys the bright, silly illustrations and the story is long enough to keep her attention, but not so long that she becomes bored with it. She loves books, and always wants to help turn the pages. I love reading her board books so she can enjoy turning the pages, but mommy doesn't have to worry about the pages being ripped out. She loves the story and turning the pages, and I love that she enjoys reading. It's a win-win.

This book is the best! I have never been a fan of Dr. Seuss, but ALL KIDS love THE FOOT BOOK. I was given the book when my first grandchild was born and he was reading it to me (easy to remember) when he was 2. Since then all my grandchildren go for this book before toys when they come to my house. I had to recently buy another because my first one was starting to fall apart. I always include this book with a baby shower gift. By the way, the ages of my grandchildren are 1, 2, 6 and 12.

I was raised with Dr. Seuss Books, now time for the next generations. Grand-kids love it when I visit and read a book to go to sleep. It is the perfect way to get them to relax, either for nap or bed. Gives nice subject to dream about too.

I was very disappointed when I received this book. I guess I didn't really understand the description of the book. I was expecting it to be the same size as the books that I had grown up with but it is half that size. I wanted to use this book as a gift for my sister. She is having a baby soon and I wanted the nurse to put the baby's foot prints in the book for her. That can't be done in this book. I think because the book is half the size of what I was expecting but the images are not reduced there is no blank space in this book for the nurse to put the baby's footprints in there. I did give her the book to read to her baby but I have had to hunt for what I was looking for. Please be aware that this book is shorter than the books we grew up with by about half. Do not expect to receive a book that you would be able to put baby footprints in or even write a message on the inside cover.

It is smaller than we wanted. We were hoping to put our newborns foot impression into it, but it is also glossy so we couldn't. Book is fine, we just missed some of the details that we were looking for.

My favorite Dr. Seuss book. I used to read it to my kids and we would lift our legs as we read it. :) I always give it as a baby gift

It is a shortened version, but still cute. Gets to the main point... feet feet feet. If you do not know the original version, you will not even know the book is shortened.
